Paul's Story

Paul was living in supported accommodation but was very vulnerable and unhappy in his local community. Paul had little contact with his family, very few friends and felt lonely and isolated. Paul was referred to Dunfermline Advocacy by his Care Worker who recognised that he would benefit from having someone in his life who was independent of any services and a regular friendly face.

Dunfermline Advocacy introduced Paul to his advocate Robert, and they soon established a weekly arrangement to meet up for a coffee and have a chat - mostly discussing their favourite football team.

Paul has greatly valued Robert's friendship over the past two years and his partnership with Robert has had a very positive impact on him, allowing Paul to be more vocal on his likes and dislikes to care staff.
